2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile phone) when you visit a website. 3. Categories of Cookies We Use

3.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

They include cookies that maintain your institutional-client classification acknowledgement during your session, your jurisdictional notice acknowledgement, and your cookie consent preferences. You cannot opt out of these cookies as the website cannot function properly without them.

3.2 Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use the website, including which pages are most frequently visited, how visitors navigate the site, and whether visitors encounter any errors. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous. We use this data to improve the website experience and content relevance for institutional and professional clients.

3.3 Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make (such as language or region preferences) and provide enhanced features. They may be set by the Company or by third-party service providers whose services we have integrated into our pages.

3.4 Targeting and Advertising Cookies
